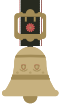

# Canadian Brown Swiss And Braunvieh Association Annual General Meeting

The 141<sup>st</sup> Canadian Brown Swiss and Braunvieh Association Annual General Meeting (AGM) was held on Friday January 26, 2024. The meeting was in person in Calgary with a virtual Teams option available for those who were unable to attend. It was great to have a full meeting table in Calgary and with those on line there were 21 members present.



Dave Rousseau, President, presided as the Chair of the meeting and all present were welcomed.

## Business Highlights of the AGM

A review of the Financial Statement was given from the Compilation Engagement Report provided by RLB Chartered Professional Accountants. The Association had a higher surplus at the end of 2023 than 2022 and this was mainly due to the increase in registration activity.

One proposed by-law was presented – BRAUNVIEH RULES OF ELIGIBILITY – adding that all Original Purebred Braunvieh females be tested prior to registration of progeny. Reasoning for this addition to the by-law is to preserve the Original Braunvieh genetics.

The proposed by-law will be sent to the Minister of Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada for approval and once approved will be updated in the Associations by-laws and implemented.

Also, one Resolution was presented proposing Brown Swiss and Braunvieh Canada introduce a computerized “Star Brood Cow” award. Both by-law and resolution were passed by member vote.

The resolution was reviewed by the Brown Swiss Breed Improvement Committee, and will be incorporated into the criteria for calculating the award, planned to be introduced at the end of 2024. A Star Brood Award was available in the past by application and now it will be generated automatically by computerized calculation.

During the AGM the 2023 awards were presented for the 2023 Class Leaders, All Time Class Leaders, Top Composite BCA Cow, 2022 Top BCA Herds 25 and over, Top BCA Herds under 25 cows and the 2023 Brown Swiss 4-H All-Canadian. All awards listings can be seen on <http://www.browncow.ca> under Information and Awards / Show & Production Results 2023. Congratulations to all the animals and breeder recipients of these awards.

Following the formal business Chair Dave Rousseau opened the floor for questions, comments or other business. During this time, it was brought forth that with the number of memberships decreasing; the Board of Directors should review the by-law related Officers. There was also discussion on the number of Officers and that they must reflect our by-laws based on the demographic requirements and membership stipulations.

As a follow-up to these discussions the Board of Directors have set up an Amendments Committee to review the by-law section on Officers and Committees. They would like to invite interested members to participate on this committee. Your experience, ideas and feedback are invaluable and if you are interested in participating on this committee, please let us know.

This committees primary mandate this year will be to review the by-law section – Officers and Committees and make recommendations to the Board of Directors.

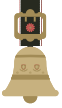

## Message From Our President

The year 2023 gave us the opportunity to attend our Annual General Meeting in person again, in the picturesque setting of Calgary. I would like to extend my thanks to all those who came out to make this event a success, but especially to Dana Vos for the time and dedication she devoted to organizing this wonderful day. Dinner was delectable, and the evening ended with a most original silent auction.

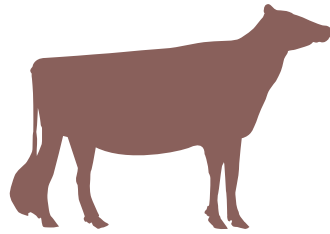
Our Genetic Improvement Committee has been very active over the last few months, reviewing regulations related to weight calculations for the Master Breeder award. At the same time, we implemented the Star Brood Cow award, so by the end of next year, eligible cows will receive their Star Brood Cow certificates. We are very proud of the addition of this award, as it gives great visibility to the animals of our Canadian breeders.

We have also been working hard on the classification grid to reduce the impact of Stature on the final score, placing greater emphasis on Rib Openness and Chest Width to obtain a more balanced animal capable of producing more milk while improving longevity. In addition, we adjusted the measurements for Pin Bone Width and decided to standardize them according to those used in the European classification system. These changes should be implemented towards the end of April 2024 and will enable Classifiers to better score our animals, which are less wide in this part of the body than the Holstein breed. We look forward to seeing how these adjustments evolve.

Despite the absence of a National Brown Swiss Show in Canada, we are pleased to see how enthusiastic young people in the 4-H Program are about showing Brown cows at the Classic. Congratulations to the 2023 All-Canadian 4-H winners! We also had the chance to admire the excellent performance of some Canadian breeders at the Hamburg, NY Spring Show at the end of March 2024. Congratulations to all!

Finally, as you will see in the magazine, we would like to open up positions on some of our Association's Committees to breeders wishing to join us. There will be a lot of work to do on the by-laws over the next few months to address the issue of provincial representation that was raised at our last AGM. We are delighted to see a growing number of breeders wanting to get involved in our Association.

### PICTURES:

It shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor to secure and supply the photos of animals being entered in the All-Canadian Contest.

The photos must be 5 x 7 unretouched black and white or color glossy prints.

Pictures must be made during the current year and show the animal in the same stage of growth as when she qualified in the show ring.

The judges will have the authority to remove pictures from the contest if picture quality standards have not been met.

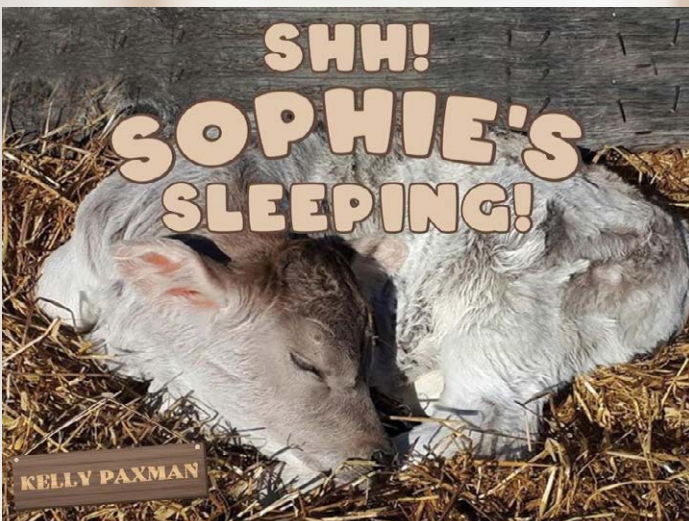
## Sylvie Schimann's 4-H Story



Hello! My name is Sylvie Schimann. I am 12 years old and live in Prince George, British Columbia, Canada. I am also a member of the Prince George Northwest 4-H club.

My steer Bart, was born on March 15, 2022 on the Double H Ranch owned by local breeders Tom Houchen and Joanne Hawkins. Bart is a pure Braunvieh steer. He was my first steer project and I really enjoyed working with him. Bart was friendly, quite easy to train on a halter, and fairly adaptable to new things. He finished at 1,320 pounds and showed very well at the Fair. We placed First Row in Market Class and Junior Showmanship. With a respectable 3.6 pounds per day gained between April 16, 2023 and August 16, 2023, Bart placed third in the Highest Rate of Gain Award. To top it off, his carcass scored a AAA grade with a 58% lean yield. I am really proud of our results! I would highly recommend Braunvieh's for a first-time cattle owner and 4-H projects!

# Greetings To Everyone from Alberta

Hello Everyone,

Life has been good – I can truly say that we have the best of two worlds. How so, you wonder?

The start of it all was in 2006, we had a young girl from Germany (Michaela) live a half year on the farm with us. She loved our docile herd and spent hours helping us with the cattle, saying that Braunvieh were the most beautiful cows of all. After travelling around, gaining a variety of experiences in different farming operations and going back to school in Germany for a couple of years, Michaela returned to Canada. She married a Buffalo farmer and they now have two young boys (5-year old Luke and 2-year old Tommy).

We always kept in touch with each other and visited often. She even asked me to be her bridesmaid at the wedding. Good grief, I thought, before reluctantly accepting. My vision was to be recorded in the Guinness Book of Records as “the oldest bridesmaid ever”. I just hoped that I wouldn’t foul up the speech I was expected to give (it went well to my relief).

Just after the second boy was born Michaela and family came for another visit and during this visit she mentioned that she would like to buy some Braunvieh cows, she wanted to start a herd.

This was at a time when we had tried for years to choose the right successor for our farm and animals – someone interested in maintaining the Original Braunvieh herd we had built. We had advertised through “Young Agrarians” and “Farmlink”, talked to many, but hadn’t yet found the right person(s) to consider a transition. So, we put two and two together and thought “how about Michaela taking over the herd with us as partners?”. We made some plans and ever since we have the best of two worlds.

**The first world** – We didn’t “lose” our beloved Braunvieh. We gained a great partner that is doing a great job and keeping us entertained with all sorts of cattle tales and pictures of new born calves. Michaela and her husband Albert are interested in learning and they are all for maintaining the Original Braunvieh breed. The first year, Michaela calved out two thirds of our cows and we did the rest. This year, she took on the entire calving and Albert does the feeding and bedding. We go help here and there, but the brunt of the work is being done by them and we are welcome to go visit the cows at any time. I do miss them, however, most of them will return here to our farm for summer grazing.

**The second world** – We are free to do things we didn’t have time to do before. We didn’t want to fully retire and do nothing at all. Oh no, no farmer is made that way! You all know that feeling – one wants to be useful. So, we are still keeping very busy. We still winter the bulls, a few heifer calves and some feeder steers at our place, but no more getting up during the nights to check on cows. I also still do the record keeping, while teaching Michaela. Promotion and decision on sales and such we do together for now.

It is perfect, both calving seasons Michaela did a great job. All the babies are healthy and vigorous and she has only a couple of old straggler cows left to calf for the year.

**Farmfair International** – In my last newsletter I mentioned that we were again going to Farmfair. Bringing cattle there in 2023 was our 26th time. We haven’t missed a year since we started in 1997 (except the year 2020, when Covid shut everything down). We hope with the help of our partners we will be able to make it up to 30 times – if we

stay healthy, that is. Getting older does set some limits.

Anyways, regarding the 2023 show, Dana Vos managed to get a few comments and pictures sent prior to the printing of the last Bell. For this issue, we will submit a few more photo’s that became available afterwards.



**Farmfair will celebrate its 50th anniversary this year** and the attendance will likely increase. Therefore, we should get entries submitted as early as possible - entries open on September 1st and close October 1st. In 2023 we had our very first show of “Braunvieh only” animals. Before that, we always showed against all other breeds that has insufficient numbers to be on their own. We would sure like to see the Braunvieh having their own show again, which means we have a minimum of three breeders and 15 animals to qualify. Last year, we had five breeders and 21 animals. Hopefully, many of you can bring in a couple of animals or more to make at least 20 head. We would appreciate you contacting us regarding this matter ASAP because we have to confirm to the Committee that we will have enough participants for our own show. They would like to know by end of June, or sooner.

**The 2024 Annual General Meeting** on January 26th was well attended and we appreciated the time of everyone that has the opportunity to participate. It was great to be able to hold it here in the West. Dana Vos did all the planning and organizing and she did an excellent job all around. Without her ideas, efforts and enthusiasm, this would never have become a reality this year.

**Florian Eberl**, a well-known Braunvieh breeder from the early seventies passed away January 29th, 2024 at the age of almost 95. We first met Florian at his farm in Claresholm in 1984, when we purchased two of his Original Braunvieh cows. One of them was sired by his famous bull “Bouncer” and the other was sired by a son of Bouncer and both those cows were out of imported females. These two animals were the beginning of our Original Braunvieh herd and still make great contribution to our existing herd 40 years later through AI.

Florian was born in Austria and worked in Switzerland prior to coming to Canada. More of his interesting life can be read on the Internet under Florian Josef Eberl – Zentner Funeral Homes. Florian was a well-respected man of high work ethics and integrity. He will be missed by all that knew him.

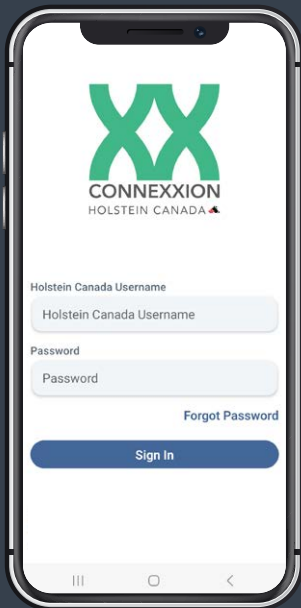

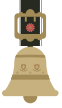

# Polled or Hornless Animals

In recent years, breeders have become increasingly interested in polled (hornless) animals. The question on everyone's mind is why this dominant gene is so rare in the population. This is because, until recently, no economic value (\$\$) was really attached to this gene, as breeders dehorned their animals themselves. Moreover, in the past, the PP or Pp gene was a limiting factor for bulls. Consequently, the current enthusiasm for polled bulls is driven by animal welfare standards and genetic progress in the breed. This short article will hopefully help our readers understand the issue a little more clearly.

The first thing to remember is that every animal has a pair of genes (two) in its genetic code that determine whether or not it will have horns. At conception, a calf inherits a gene for this trait from each of its parents. It is also important to know that the "polled" gene (P) dominates the "horned" gene (p). Based on these statements, we then have three possible genetic combinations:

### 1. The animal receives two "polled" genes (PP) from its parents

The animal will be polled and considered "homozygous" because it has two identical genes for this trait. Since these are two dominant genes, this animal will only produce polled calves, no matter what type of animal it is mated with.

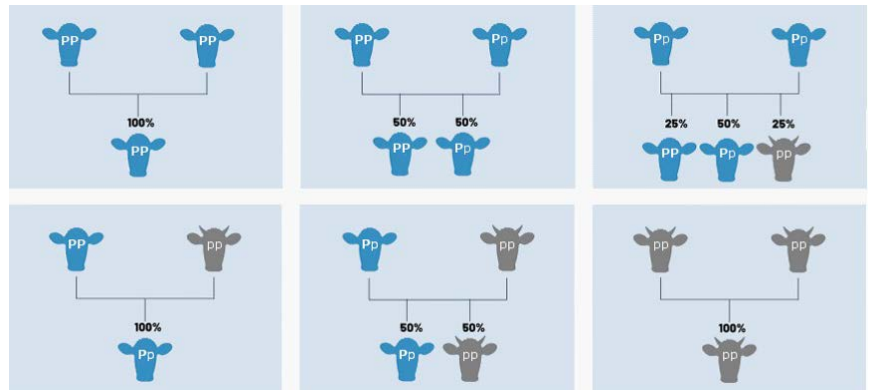
### 2. The animal receives the "polled" gene (Pp) from one of its parents and the "horned" gene (pp) from the other

The animal will itself be polled since (P) dominates (p). It will be referred to as "heterozygous polled" because it carries two different genes. It will produce no more than 50% of polled calves, assuming it is mated only with horned animals (see table).

### 3. The animal receives two "horned" genes (pp) from its parents

This is the only combination that will produce only horned cattle since the dominant polled gene is not present.

To get a better idea, let's look at the six different possibilities in the following table:



We now understand why it is so important for breeders wishing to obtain polled calves to know the difference between the words homozygous (PP) and heterozygous (Pp).

# How to Maximize Genetic Progress in Your Herd

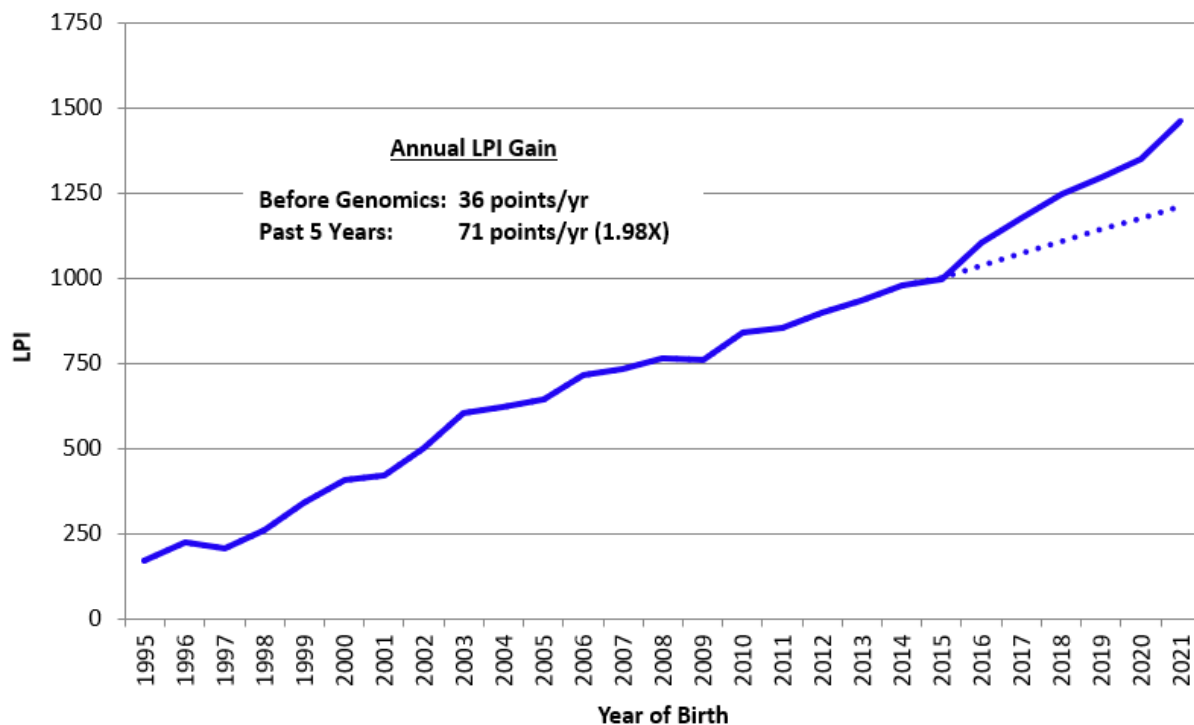
When it comes to reaching your herd goals, selecting which animals as parents of the next generation in your herd is arguably one of the most important decisions. With so much valuable information available today, what are the key areas to focus on to maximize your herd’s genetic potential and reach your goals faster?

## Achieving Genetic Progress

The rate of genetic gain per year in the Canadian Brown Swiss population continues to improve year over year, as illustrated in Figure 1 for the national selection index, LPI.

$$\text{Genetic Gain} = \frac{\text{Genetic Variation} \times \text{Intensity} \times \text{Accuracy}}{\text{Generation Interval}}$$

**Figure 1: Genetic Trend Realized for LPI in Canadian Brown Swiss females**



This progress in genetic improvement is dependent on four key factors including genetic variation, selection intensity, accuracy of selection and generation interval. Let’s dive into each of these areas further:

**Genetic Variation:** The genetic variability of a trait. Without some level of genetic variation there would be no differences between animals and therefore no opportunity for genetic selection. The genetic variation of a trait does not change significantly over time and is therefore not a significant factor affecting the genetic gain realized in your herd compared to others.

**Selection Intensity:** How many animals you choose to breed the next generation and how genetically superior they are. You’ll make faster progress if you select only the highest ranked sires and mate them to the highest genetic females in your herd to produce the next generation of heifers for your herd.



**Accuracy of Selection:** This is reflected by the level of Reliability of the genetic evaluations used to make selection and mating decisions, which can vary depending on the trait heritability, inclusion of genomics, and the amount of performance and pedigree data available.

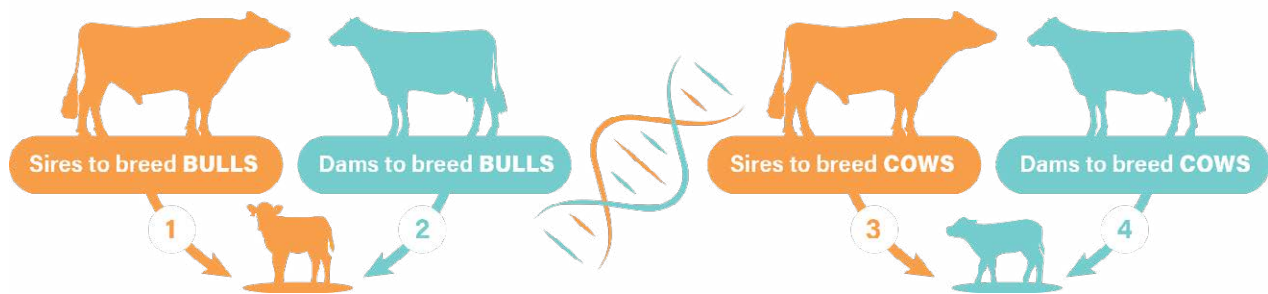
**Generation Interval:** The average age of selected parents when their offspring are born. Dairy farmers can maximize the rate of genetic progress in their herd when selection intensity and accuracy are high while the generation interval is as low as possible.

### Four Pathways to Selection

To put this in practice in the context of dairy cattle breeding we need to consider the four distinct pathways to selection illustrated in Figure 2. These include the selection of (1) sires to breed bulls, (2) dams to breed bulls, (3) sires to breed cows, and (4) dams to breed cows. The formula for genetic gain outlined above can be calculated within each of these four pathways and then summed to determine the total genetic progress per year within a dairy population, or within a specific herd.

Figure 2: The Four Pathways to Dairy Cattle Selection

## Four Pathways to Selection



Pathways 1 and 2, which relate to the selection of sires and dams to breed bulls, are mainly used by AI companies and breeders that are selling bulls. For this article, we will focus on pathways 3 and 4, since they relate to the selection of sires and dams to breed cows. After all, deciding which sires to use and dams to breed to create replacements has a big impact on maximizing the rate of genetic progress within your herd and the Brown Swiss breed. As outlined previously, the two main factors that drive faster genetic gain are maximizing the accuracy and intensity of selection.

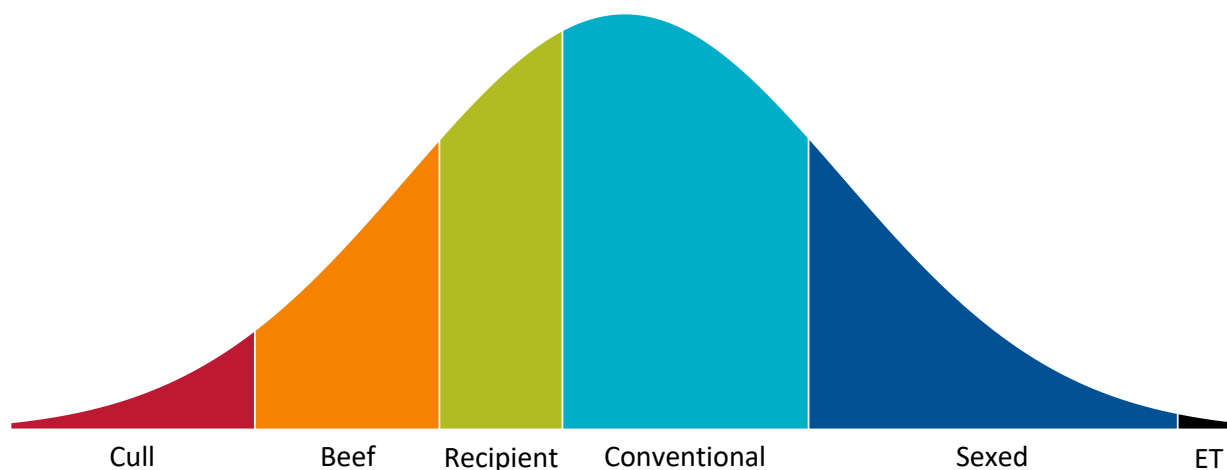
### Maximizing the Accuracy of Selection

Genotyping has the biggest influence on the accuracy of selection. The adoption of genomics in 2014 led to more accurate genomic evaluations for bulls and cows across the dairy industry and accelerated the rate of genetic change. For the Brown Swiss breed, the average LPI Reliability increases by 25 percentage points through genomic testing of heifers and young bulls. All Brown Swiss bulls offered by A.I. organizations have been genotyped and therefore have an official genomic evaluation published by Lactanet. Genotyping your cows and heifers also contributes to breed improvement and results in a more accurate ranking of your females due to the increased level of Reliability. In addition, genomic testing helps to manage genetic abnormalities in the Canadian Brown Swiss population. Genotyping also allows herd owners to test for favourable traits such as polled or milk properties that improve digestibility. Overall, the more data we have on bulls and cows, including genotypes, the more accurate animals will be ranked and thus the more genetic progress is achievable both in an individual herd and within the Brown Swiss breed.

### Maximizing Selection Intensity

When it comes to maximizing selection intensity, the focus is selecting the highest ranked sires and dams to produce the next generation. Developing an on-farm breeding plan for intentional selection and mating, such as Figure 3, can help you decide which reproductive strategies to use for each animal. This means either culling lower genetic merit animals or using beef semen to produce higher slaughter value crossbred calves while removing the poor genetics from your future herd. For the highest ranked females in your herd, consider using sexed semen to accelerate genetic progress. Keeping in mind this may not be the highest performing cows, it is important to look at where your animals rank from a genetic perspective. Embryo transfer (ET) is another reproductive technology used to create embryos of high genetic merit using the highest ranked sires and dams. Lower genetic merit females can then be recipients. Overall, incorporating more A.I. technologies like sexed semen and ET can lead to a large genetic change in your herd in just one generation. In general, by focusing on high genetically ranked males and females as parents of the next generation of replacement heifers also significantly reduces the generation interval, therefore further boosting the rate of genetic progress in your herd.

**Figure 1: Example of an on-farm breeding plan using different reproductive strategies**



At the end of the day, making genetic progress on your farm equates to higher producing and healthier animals for generations to come. Genetic change is controlled by several factors, but it all starts with genomic testing your heifers and cows and developing a breeding plan that incorporates more reproductive technologies using high genetic merit sires and dams as parents of the next generation.

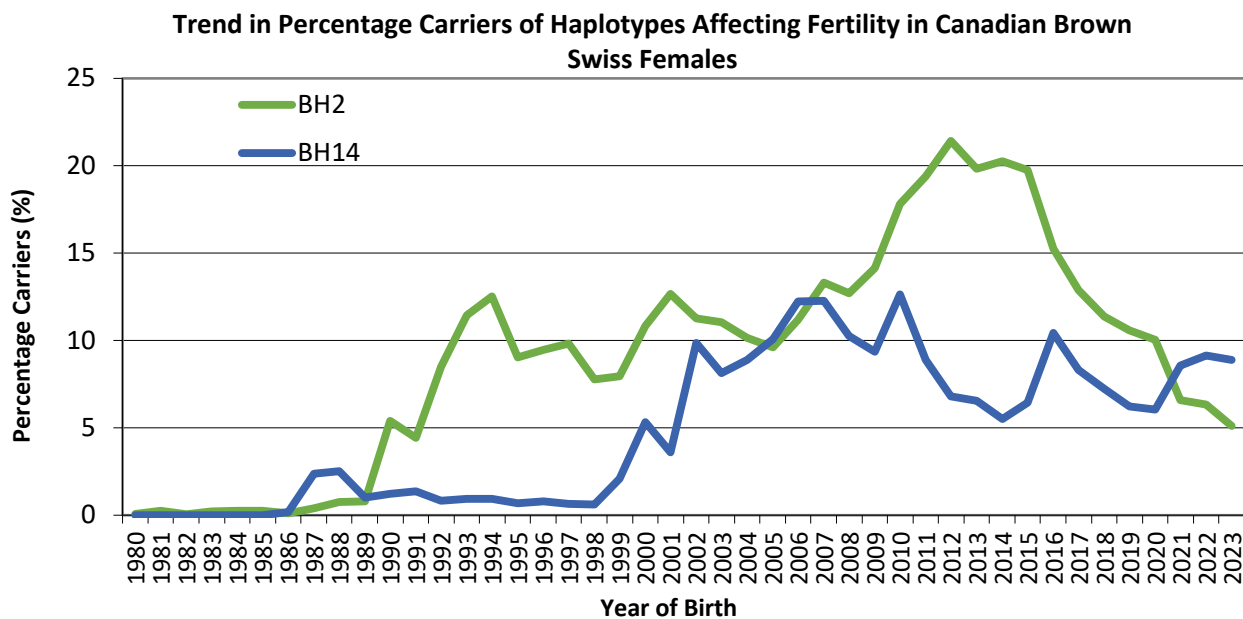

The dairy industry has reaped substantial benefits from genomics, including advancements ranging from rapid genetic improvements for essentially all traits to the identification and management of undesirable genetic conditions and haplotypes. The latest discovery of these includes the Brown Swiss Fertility Haplotype BH14. Lactanet has been publishing Carrier Probability values for the BH14 haplotype since April 2024.

First reported in Switzerland in 2022, the BH14 haplotype causes early pregnancy loss and traces back to Ventures Esp Babaray, born in 1978, as the oldest known carrier. In the April 2023 genetic evaluation release in the United States, the Council on Dairy Cattle Breeding (CDCB) began reporting BH14 results. **To reflect the likelihood that an animal carries BH14, Lactanet calculates a Carrier Probability value for every animal in its database based on known gene test results, the haplotype results received from CDCB, and pedigree data.** Like other Carrier Probability values, those for BH14 are reported as values ranging from 1%, meaning the animal is likely free of the undesirable gene, to 99% meaning the animal is likely a carrier. The BH14 status for all animals can be found on the Lactanet website using the Animal Query tool. Once you have found the animal of interest you can go to their “Genetic Evaluation Summary” page to find a pop-up box with Carrier Probability values for BH14 along with BH2. Alternatively, navigate to the animal’s “Pedigree” page to access Carrier Probability values for the animal as well as its parents and grandparents.

The illustration below shows the trend in estimated average carrier probability for both Brown Swiss haplotypes, namely BH14 as well as BH2, which causes early embryonic loss or stillbirth. **The average carrier frequency for BH14 has fluctuated for the last several years but is almost 9% for Canadian females born in 2023.** To date, Brown Swiss breeders have effectively decreased the frequency of BH2 and should apply the same approach to continue reducing this trend along with BH14.



### Managing BH14

Now that BH14 in Brown Swiss is known and reported, industry strategies can be used to reduce the occurrence that carrier animals are mated together, effectively lowering the frequency of the causative undesirable gene in the breed population. Lactanet now publishes Carrier Probability values for BH14 to assist in mating decisions. Carrier animals do not directly cause a problem in the population. However, if such carrier females are mated with a carrier bull, then 25% of the resulting pregnancies or offspring will be affected. **It is important to closely monitor Carrier Probability values before making mating decisions to effectively reduce the frequency within your herd and the Brown Swiss breed.**

The Lactanet website is an excellent resource to help manage known undesirable genetic conditions and haplotypes and make better breeding decisions. A pop-up box was recently added to each animal’s Genetic Evaluation Summary, Inbreeding Calculator and Pedigree pages to view their Carrier Probability values for the main genetic conditions and haplotypes. The Inbreeding Calculator also contains new visuals to assist producers in identifying potential matings that have a risk of producing a pregnancy or calf affected by these undesirable genes. Together, the dairy industry can continue to identify and manage undesirable genes, leading to improved herd reproduction, health, and welfare, which translate to increased profitability.
