When Longevity Rimes With Profitability



Mr. Louis Rousseau, owner of Ferme Pauferlou, has something to be proud of! As a matter of fact, this dairy operation finished 1st this year in the TPI provincial ranking and 2nd based on the Canadian ranking. Was it pure chance? Certainly not!

The success of this dairy operation lies on the work, perseverance and dedication of four generations of dairy producers. They have been part of the landscape of Pohénégamook (Saint-Éleuthère) in the beautiful Lower St. Lawrence region since the village was created! Named after the first three owners (Paul, Fernand and Louis Rousseau), Ferme Pauferlou will soon be under the responsibility of Marc-Antoine Rousseau, the 4th generation to take over the family patrimony. What is the secret of their success? They are always keeping abreast of changes and on the lookout for new developments. The owners show an openness for new practices and new ideas, and they surround themselves well with trusted partners with whom they can work as a team to ensure the performance and the sustainability of their operation.

A Brief Overview of Ferme Pauferlou inc.

Louis and Marc-Antoine Rousseau

(father and son), both graduates of the ITA La Pocatière, rigorously manage their 28-cow herd, including 24 milking cows. Composed of 65% Brown Swiss and 35% Holsteins, their herd allows them to produce a quota of 51.1 kg. Their land of 89 hectares is used for the cultivation of forage plants and reed canary grass to ensure their self-sufficiency in straw. In terms of feeding, they have opted since 2013 for a complete TMR with round bales of hay from mixed 1st and 2nd cuts. They also raise heifers with a good selection at mating.

Recipients of the Très Grande Distinction and Grande Distinction certificates for milk quality each year since 2009, the Bronze and Silver certificates in 2005 and 2006, and the Gold certificate on the regional level in 2009, they are decidedly committed to producing quality milk while managing their operation with master hands. What a beautiful family heritage!

Always Room for Improvement

Despite the fact that those owners consider that all management criteria are important and closely linked, several

efforts have been invested in the reproduction and feeding side over the last few years. For them, the profitability of their herd is through its longevity!

In terms of reproduction (reproduction protocol: double 7-2-1), they have seen since January 2015 a significant improvement in the calving interval and conception rate. Thanks to the support of Valacta and the critical information generated by the analysis of the various reports (for example: heifer breeding summary, reproduction monitoring, animals with pregnancy diagnosis...) and their veterinarian who supports them with monthly visits and ensures a follow-up on reproduction, the results are conclusive!

Dealing with the challenge of ketosis in the herd, they have also put considerable emphasis on feeding (TMR). They called on Valérie Martin, strategic advisor for Valacta, at the time the RTM was installed, in order to get some advice on the integration of less costly feed. Valérie, who knows the herd well and has a good overview of it, also provided valuable help in answering certain questions on feeding and in collaboration with the agricultural union, simplifying the analysis of the transition and the farm data. Due to this precious team work, the herd is now nearly free from ketosis, hence the good milk value that they have successfully reached.

Collaboration with the Stakeholders, a Key Factor to Success
We can easily say that the Rousseau family has surrounded itself well to achieve the results that it is displaying today. Their performance is certainly enhanced by the expertise provided by the various stakeholders who revolve around their operation. Whether it be the hoof trimmer who visits the farm about 3 times per year, the veterinarian who comes by on a monthly basis to ensure the herd's health or the feed consultants, tax expert and accountant, not forgetting the various consulting services and techniques offered by the Valacta regional staff. All are committed to contributing in their own way to the achievements of Ferme Pauferlou's results.

Much More Than a Simple Recognition

For the present management of Ferme Pauferlou, their provincial and national ranking in terms of TPI is much more than a simple recognition. It is a great pride and the irrefutable proof that the actions undertaken on the farm are bearing fruit. Mr. Rousseau declares, "The TPI is the most important recognition for us. It represents the whole management of our herd".

What Future Lays Ahead for Ferme Pauferlou?

In the medium term, Mr. Louis Rousseau, the present owner, wishes to proceed with the final transfer of the operation to his son Marc-Antoine, within approximately 4 years. In the meantime, the latter benefits from the precious advice and the support of his father while already taking care of the accounting, the herd management and the daily chores related to the management of a dairy farm.

If you ask Marc-Antoine Rousseau what his vision for the future is, he will answer without hesitation: "We wish to maximize the production for 45 milking cows with the ultimate objective of transferring the herd in a free stall environment".

In the meantime, there are many projects ongoing at Ferme Pauferlou to ensure the profitability of this family operation.

- In order to optimize the comfort and the housing of the heifers and dry cows, they intend to proceed with the building of a cold barn where the animals would be in a free stall system.
- They also wish to improve the work and milking efficiency by automating the herd feeding and proceeding with the addition of rails.
- They will also proceed to install mattresses to replace the old carpets to increase the animal comfort.

What a nice way to ensure continuity!

Swissgenetics Breeding Value Highlights August 2017





Two wide-scale projects are now underway in Quebec.



We cannot take the credit of the original idea of those two projects because both are an initiative of people from Ayrshire. The first project is an Ayrshire Canada collaborative project of money available at the federal level that aimed to compare different types of ration in Ayrshire herd.

In collaboration with the MAPAQ and Valacta, we could set up a research project to find solutions to improve the performance of Brown Swiss herds enrolled in the dairy control.

In 2015, in Quebec, Valacta's average milk level was 7,511 kg for the breed Brown Swiss. The most efficient producers in Brown Swiss breeding produced 8,837 kg of milk (percentile 90), whereas others reached a low level of 5,801 kg (percentile 10). This significant difference puts some of the companies at risk in terms of their competitiveness and profitability.

Few studies and research have been realized on the race. This has resulted in a herd management that may be less suitable for the Brown Swiss. This could be the case in food where producers give the same ration of Holstein cows to Brown Swiss cows, on the pretext that they have the same size. This may lead to fewer satisfactory technical and economic performances of the breed. But is the lack only in the ration or other components influencing the performance of Brown Swiss cows? Therefore, a better understanding about the factors of success to help the Brown Swiss breeders to progress.

The objective of the project is to give an accurate overall picture of production (e.g., production gaps and distribution, reproductive cycles, milk income and food margin). By analyzing the factors influencing deviations: composition and costs of rations, replacement, breeding condition, milk quality of Brown Swiss herds. At the end of the project, we hope to be able to formulate overall recommendations and ways to improve the profitability of farms with Brown Swiss herds.

To achieve this purpose the project comprises five activities.

Activity 1: Dairy control data for Brown Swiss cows and herds will be analyzed in detail to establish a more precise overall profile of the strengths and weaknesses. Some tests will be carried out at the level of individual cows to take into account only Brown Swiss cows in mixed herds. Some comparisons will be made with other breeds with small livestock to check if the discrepancies observed between Brown Swiss are also found in other breeds.

Activity 2: In addition to regular checks, 15 herds among the 30 Brown Swiss predominant will be visited to collect additional data with the Valacta feed margin tool (data on concentrates and fodder distributed, and delivery data to the PLQ, on a 12-month period). Growth analysis software will also allow to enter weight data for heifers. The flesh states will be entered via the LacT software, and an assessment of the comfort will be made by a survey of injuries to the knees and hocks.

Activity 3: Detailed analysis of individual dairy control reports will be carried out to detect trends and generate assumptions to be validated by batch data analysis at the next panel.

Activity 4: Dairy control data will be combined with additional data collected on farms to validate the assumptions established in the previous activity.

Activity 5: Findings from the analyzes will be used to formulate recommendations for all livestock and farms with Brown Swiss on potential improvements and possible solutions.

A second project, an idea of Ayrshire Quebec that we adapted for our race, was accepted this spring by the MAPAQ on Haplotype BH1 and.

BH2: effects on fertility and economic consequences in Brown Swiss breed.

The reasons for that kind of project are:

1. Considering that the age at first calving is high in the breed Brown Swiss (27 months);
2. Considering that the interval between calving is high in the breed Brown Swiss (434 days);
3. Considering that these two criteria of control have a major impact upon the efficiency and profitability of dairy herds;
4. Considering that recent studies using genomics have revealed the presence of genes liable for embryonic mortality in the Brown Swiss breed (Haplotype BH1) and the genes responsible for a stillborn calf, birth or abortion at 7-8 months of gestation (Haplotype BH2);
5. Considering that these genes are present in the Brown Swiss breed with a frequency between 5% and 35% within each year of birth;
6. From the new studies available to us, we can assume that there is a link between the presence of these genes in the breed, and the reproductive difficulties that we observe in Brown Swiss animals;
7. No database is available now to allow us to evaluate and manage these hereditary traits effectively on farms.

To do this, we will evaluate the correlation between the animals carrying the BH1 and / or BH2 haplotype in the Brown Swiss breed versus the first calving age and the calving interval among all Brown Swiss in Quebec (112 members) by collecting 1,000 samples. From the data collected, we will verify the financial impact that the presence of these haplotypes can have on age at first calving and between the calving interval in the Brown Swiss breed. By the same token, we will educate breeders about the use of genomics as new technology available to them for the management of their herds.

Based on the results obtained, to determine whether the adoption of new technology such as genomics is a feasible avenue for breeders to derive the maximum benefit from managing the reproductive efficiency and genetic improvement of their herds.

So here are a few lines of two major projects that allow us to be present with our breeders in Quebec.

Message From The Secretary-Manager's Desk



Beginning September 2017, all dairy producers in Canada will be required to meet the Animal Care and Livestock Traceability requirements. When farms are due for their CQM validation, they will also need to comply with Animal Care and Livestock Traceability requirements. The mandatory requirements related to Traceability are: Premises ID, animal ID and animal movement. There is detailed information available at <https://www.dairyfarmers.ca/proaction> or check out the next website for quick tips which are worth the read to learn more about premise ID, identifying your animals, animal identification and lost tags, tag retention, animal arrival and animal movement. https://www.holstein.ca/Public/en/Services/NLID/Livestock_Traceability. For your information, in support of proAction® when registrations are entered into the herd book, our registrar at Holstein Canada will automatically report animals registered before 45 days to CCIA, in order to save you a step.

The Board of Directors have been busy making a number of decisions. RLB was retained as the auditor for the financial statements and for the 2017 books they will be providing a "notice to reader" as the cost is much less. Translation will now be provided by Raphaelle Pelissier in order to lower the translation expense. The decision was also made to not participate at CDX in 2018. The Board accepted an invitation from the Ontario club to host the AGM in the spring of 2018.

The Breed Improvement Committee discussed a number of topics on their conference call. Changes to the classification score card were reviewed with recommendations forwarded to the Board and accepted. For further details on the classification scorecard changes implemented please contact the office. The letter from the Ontario Club regarding classification visit concerns was discussed by the BIC and the Board with recommendations forwarded to the classification department at Holstein Canada. The Board is hopeful of a positive outcome following the classifiers workshop in June when a Brown Swiss herd was visited and reviewed by the complete group of classifiers. The BIC recommended automating the Star Brood Cow award and implementing a Master Breeder Award. The work on these 2 items is well underway with Holstein Canada and we hope to provide these options by year-end. For a

number of years there has been requests to provide a catchup program. A program has been made available to any owner of Brown Swiss who has fallen behind on their Brown Swiss registrations and/or transfers. The form can be found on the association website under the link Forms & Applications.

The Board also has agreed to have the website redesigned in order to allow for accessibility of the website through cell phones and mobile devices for members as well as non-members or just interested people. The way of the future is leaning towards the use of mobile devices and providing a better experience for the viewer. Redesigning the website will also allow for smoother transition of electronic registrations, member login for account review and payments. Of the 3 quotes received, Mark Roberts from Holstein Canada will be completing the website redesign for the association.

Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada has provided ministerial approval of the amendment to the by-laws 19 3.a.iv and 20 4.a.iv as approved by the members at the AGM in March. Our registrar has been notified of the changes.

With the implementation of the monthly production award certificates, we have now received our first 2 animals to qualify for the Super3 Award. The Super3 Award recognizes high production over at least three consecutive lactations. To qualify for Super3, an animal must complete three consecutive lactations that meet the requirements for Superior Production. In order to qualify for Superior Production, an animal must complete a lactation record with a composite BCA (Fat + Protein) that is 140 points above the composite of the national breed average for that year (using the average of the last 3 years) and a composite deviation within herd (Fat + Protein) that is +30 points above herd average. Congratulations to Geoffrey McConnell/ Dun Rovin Acres with Dun Rovin Traction Zebra and to Gubelmann Brown Swiss Ltd with Gubelman Brookings Claire.
